

Let us make three tents, one for you and one for Moses and one for Elijah." ⁶ For he did not know what to say, for they were terrified. ⁷ And a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice came out of the cloud, "This is my beloved Son; listen to him." ⁸ And suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone with them but Jesus only. ⁹ And as they were coming down the mountain, he charged them to tell no one what they had seen, until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

Daily Bible Readings for Home Devotions

February 10th – 15th, 2025

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."
-Psalm 119:105

Mon John 4:25-42 Jesus reveals Himself as the Messiah to the Samaritan woman from whom He had requested some water. Water jar forgotten, she goes to share the news that He is the Savior of the world!

Tues 1 Corinthians 6:9-20 The apostle reminds the Corinthian Christians that in Christ Jesus they were washed, sanctified, justified from their former immoral behavior in order to glorify God in their body and life.

Wed Genesis 24:34-51 Abraham's servant tells how he was sent to find a wife for Isaac, his master's son, and how he prayed that the Lord's choice might be revealed to him through his asking for a drink of water.

Thurs Micah 7:14-20 Micah asks God to Shepherd His people. The Lord promises wonderful things, and Micah bursts forth in praise of a God who forgives guilt (v18), casting sins into the depths of the sea! (v19)

Fri Matthew 11:25-30 Jesus praises God the Father that He has revealed His Son and Savior, not to the world's wisdom, but to the faith of little children, to the weary and burdened, longing for spiritual rest.

Sat Genesis 28:11-17 The Lord reveals Himself to Jacob in a dream. He is the God of Jacob's fathers, who promises blessings to all through Jacob's seed. Jacob awakens believing the promise!
