Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers. ¹⁷ Every good gift and every perfect

gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. ¹⁸ Of his

own will he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures. ¹⁹ Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; ²⁰ for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God. ²¹ Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

But if I go, I will send him to you.⁸ And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment: ⁹ concerning sin, because they do not believe in me; ¹⁰ concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father, and you will see me no longer; ¹¹ concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged. ¹² "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. ¹⁴ He will alorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you. ¹⁵ All that the Father has is mine; therefore I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you.


in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth;

Mon John 17:9-19 The night before His death, Jesus prays for His disciples, that they may be protected by the Father's name (v11) from the Evil One (v15), filled with Jesus' joy (v13), set apart by His Word (17).

Tues 1 John 3:1-8 Seeing the love of God fills us with eternal hope. In view of this glorious future, let us not keep on sinning. Sin is lawlessness and from the Devil, but Jesus came to destroy the works of the Devil.

Wed Exodus 17:1-7 After having received quail in the evening and manna in the morning, in a water shortage the people were ready to give up on God. But God did not give up on them!

Thurs Isaiah 49:8-13 The promise held out to the Lord's Servant is to the benefit of the people. It means release to the prisoners, relief from hunger and thirst, shouts of joy as the Lord comforts His people.

Fri John 15:10-17 In His great love our Savior heads to the cross, desiring that His disciples remain in His love and joy. There is no greater love than His, and showing His love to one another they will bear fruit.

Sat John 16:5-15 Facing the cross tomorrow, Jesus already promises to send the Counselor to His disciples (v7). He, the Spirit of truth, will guide them into all truth, glorifying Jesus who sent Him.
