Wisdom has built her house; she has hewn her seven pillars. ² She has slaughtered

her beasts; she has mixed her wine; she has also set her table. ³ She has sent out her young women to call from the highest places in the town, ⁴ "Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!" To him who lacks sense she says, ⁵ "Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine I have mixed. ⁶ Leave your simple ways, and live, and walk in the way of insight." ⁷ Whoever corrects a scoffer gets himself abuse, and he who reproves a wicked man incurs injury. ⁸ Do not reprove a scoffer, or he will hate you; reprove a wise man, and he will love you. ⁹ Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be still wiser; teach a righteous man, and he will increase in learning. ¹⁰ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight.

Mon Matthew 5:13 Jesus calls His followers salt. Now, salt has certain abilities, like enhancing flavor. But if it loses it's abilities, it is good for nothing, no matter what it is called. Lord, help us to be what You made us!

Tues Matthew 5:14-16 Jesus, the light of the world (Jn8:12), also calls His followers "light." He does not want us to be dark or hidden, but rather to live among people in such a way as to glorify our God and Father.

Wed Acts 3:1-9 Peter and John have no money to give a lame beggar, but give him health in Jesus' name. The man enters the temple, walking, jumping and praising God. The people see and God is glorified!

Thurs Numbers 21:4-9 The peoples' complaints against God call forth His judgment. When they seek His mercy, their lives are spared through looking at a bronze snake lifted up on a pole (cp Jn3:14).

Fri Job 36:26-33 Elihu answers human complaints against God by pointing to God's goodness and power in gathering up drops of water to provide rain, how His lightning shines to the depths, and His thunder warns.

Sat Job 37:1-13 When we hear the voice of thunder, and see the lightning fill the sky, when we see the clouds swirling, and the rain and snow falling at God's direction, who are we to sit in judgment on Him?
