July 7th – 12th, 2025

Mon Matthew 5:17-19 Jesus supports the entire Old Testament, whether Law, which He will keep, or Prophets, which He will fulfill completely as our substitute, our promised Savior.

Tues Acts 3:9-26 The people were amazed to see the lame man healed, and Peter is swift to credit Jesus for the healing, as well as forgiveness (v19). In Him is the fulfillment of all the prophets' promises (v24)!

Wed Numbers 23:7-12 Balak hired Balaam, the sorcerer, to try to get the Lord to stop blessing the Israelites. But Balaam cannot manipulate the God of Israel, who is intent on blessing many through Israel.

Thurs Ezekiel 18:20-24 To go against the Lord of life means death. The prophet is clear on that. But the Lord does not desire people's death, but that they would turn back to Him and live!

Fri Matthew 5:20-26 The righteousness that Jesus gives us is greater than that of the Scribes and Pharisees. e.g. Not only will we refrain from murder, but also from hurting or harming by word or deed.

Sat Romans 6:3-11 Our new life comes from being baptized into Jesus' death, so that we might also live with Him. As He died to sin on the cross, so also we consider ourselves dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ.

Luke 15:11-24

And he said, "There was a man who had two sons. ¹²

And the younger of them said

to his father, 'Father, give me the share of property that is coming to me.' And they began to celebrate.

I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service, ¹³ though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent.
