John 14:15-21

[Jesus said:] "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Fa-

ther, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, ¹⁷ even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. ¹⁹ Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. ²¹ Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. Now who is there to harm you if you are zealous for what is good? ¹⁴ But even if you

should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, nor be troubled, ¹⁵ but in your hearts regard Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; ¹⁶ yet do it with gentleness and respect, having a good conscience, so that, when you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ may be put to shame. ¹⁷ For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that should be God's will, than for doing evil. ¹⁸ For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, ¹⁹ in which he went and proclaimed to the

spirits in prison, ²⁰ because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. ²¹ Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, ²² who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him.

Acts 17:22-34

So Paul, standing in the midst of the Areopagus, said: "Men of Athens, I perceive that in every way you are very religious. ²³ For as I passed along and observed the objects of your worship, I found also an altar with this inscription: 'To the unknown god.' What therefore you worship as unknown, this I proclaim to you. ²⁴ The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth,

does not live in temples made by man, ²⁵ nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything. ²⁶ And he made from one man every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined allotted periods and the boundaries of their dwelling place, ²⁷ that they should seek God, and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him. Yet he is actually not far from each one of us, ²⁸ for "In him we live and move and have our being"; as even some of your own poets have said, "For we are indeed his offspring." ²⁹ Being then God's offspring, we ought not to think that the divine being is like gold or silver or stone, an image formed by the art and imagination of man. ³⁰ The times of ignorance God overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent, ³¹ because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead." ³² Now when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked. But others said, "We will hear you again about this." ³³ So Paul went out from their midst. ³⁴ But some men joined him and believed, among whom also were Dionysius the Areopagite and a woman named Damaris and others with them.

Daily Bible Readings for Home Devotions

May 11th - 16th, 2026

Mon John 16:23-30 Jesus looks forward to a time when His disciples will take their requests straight to the Father in His name (v23). As He prepares to leave the world, He assures them of the Father's love (v27).

Tues James 1:22-27 May the Word enter not only our ears. May it also enter our hearts and move us to act accordingly. Then we will be able to bridle our tongues and show God's mercy to orphans and widows.

Wed Jeremiah 29:11-14 The Lord's plans for His people are truly good. He would have them seek Him with all their heart. They will find Him, and He will gather them from all places of exile unto Himself.

Thurs Psalm 124 In Jesus' ascension to heaven (Acts1:1-11), we see that He is more than just another man. Emphasized by repetition: it was the Lord God who was for us (v1-2). We have escaped (v7) by His help (v8).

Fri Psalm 84 God's children love the place where He, the living God, is! How blessed are all who live in His presence and find their strength in His grace and glory (v11). Blessed is the one who trusts in Him! (V12)

Sat Romans 8:24-28 After Jesus' ascension, the disciples looked forward to the coming of the Spirit with His gifts. He helps us in our weakness when we pray, and He helps us to trust God's good purposes for us.
